Security operations

The pandemic has resulted in a drastic drop in passenger volumes across the aviation industry, leading to reduced aeronautical revenues for the airlines as well as airport authorities, causing massive layoffs across the industry. With a reduction in security calls for service and fewer experienced eyes and ears at the airport to report suspicious activities we have noted an increase in the level of complacency among employees, security staff and even the police. For the past 18 or so months, we feel that complacency has been become our number one security challenge and we have sought to address this through strategies such as increasing virtual security training and red teaming. This has helped keep our staff vigilant, security focused and ready for the anticipated increase in passenger volumes as we eagerly await a return to the "new normal" in aviation. I will be addressing the above topics during my session at International Airport Summit.
